Single-use boxes made from potato starch

→ Preferably compost on site or dispose of with organic waste.

→ Preferably compost on site or dispose of with organic waste.

Single-use boxes made from bio-based plastic

Separate for composting collection. If facilities do not exist, avoid these materials. If you must use them, dispose of with general

waste. **Do NOT home compost**.

Single-use boxes made from recycled plastic

Separate for plastic recycling.
